


A SITE OF HISTORICAL IMPORTANCE

Established in Lee-on-the-Solent in 1917, HMS Daedalus was a naval aviation base that would go on to play a crucial role in the D-Day landings. Originally a training centre of seaplane pilots for anti-submarine patrols, the base was only intended to be temporary. Following the creation of the Royal Air Force in 1918, HMS Daedalus became home to the Fleet Air Arm, the title given to flying naval elements of the RAF who were stationed at the base, although this title wasn't officially adopted until 1937. No fewer than 847 different seaplanes, flying boats and landbased aircraft were based at Lee-on-the-Solent from 1917-1937, demonstrating the base's tactical importance, it was even host to King George V for his silver jubilee celebrations.

Daedalus was at the forefront of fighting activity during WWII, defending the coastline during the Battle of Britain and playing a vital role in Operation Overlord. On D-Day itself it was the busiest air station on the south coast. After 79 years of continuous operation HMS Daedalus was decommissioned in 1991. A vital station for the training of personnel, home to countless military families and the development of military systems which have enabled the air services to remain at the forefront of military aviation, Daedalus remains an important site in the history of Lee-on-the-Solent.

SHARED OWNERSHIP

Shared Ownership is a fantastic and affordable way to get onto the property ladder if you're unable to purchase outright on the open market. You purchase an affordable share of your chosen property, either outright or with a mortgage, and then pay a low-cost rent on the remainder.

Shared Ownership gives you many of the benefits of home ownership, such as the ability to decorate and hang pictures however you wish, but also comes at a lower cost than buying on the open market. You may only need a deposit of 5% of the value of the share you're actually buying not of the whole purchase price and can gradually increase your share until you own 100% of your home. Shares in properties at Daedalus Village are available from 30% for a one bedroom and 40% for a two bedroom home.

*Figures are based on a 95%, 25 year mortgage with an interest rate of 3.99% ^Rental figures based on unsold equity at 2.75% of value.


