

The Paradise Wildlife Park, for example, will bring you face to face with life-size animatronic dinosaurs, while the magnificent Hatfield House is inspiring both inside and out with extensive grounds that host open air concerts and film nights. There are few locations that can claim a historic park on their doorstep, but that's exactly what you will have living at Oakwood. Panshanger Park was originally designed by the famous 18th century landscape artist Capability Brown and this unique mosaic of open spaces is today home to water voles, kingfishers, red kites and many rare species.

It's a park that changes with the seasons and there are always new things to see. One day you might be admiring the bluebells in Lady Hughes Wood or spotting wildfowl on Osprey Lake, the next you could be walking among the ancient oaks or soaking up the sunshine beside the tranquil River Mimram. With the park so close to your front door, you can enjoy a different adventure every day.



WHERE THE TRAVELLING

IS EASY

Living at Oakwood, you have some of the best parts of the country on hand. London is only a few miles to the South and easy to reach for a day exploring the shops or a night out on the town. Head North and East Anglia opens up for you. Maybe you fancy a day at the races in Newmarket or wandering the fascinating streets of Cambridge. Perhaps a weekend on the coast takes your fancy, or a holiday boating on the Norfolk Broads. And when you wish to travel further afield, it's easy to get to the Midlands and North, via the Great North Road.

BY RAIL

If you commute into London, Hertford North station will connect you with London King's Cross or Moorgate in 50 minutes. There are also good services to Stevenage and other local destinations.

BY ROAD

From Oakwood you have access to a wide range of road networks. The A10 is your direct road to the centre of London and provides a quick connection to the M25 and national motorway network. It also links you with Cambridge and East Anglia. The A1(M) runs to the West of Hertford which gives is your direct route all the way up to Doncaster, Durham, Newcastle and Edinburgh.

BUS SERVICES

Oakwood is well served by buses connecting you to villages in the surrounding area as well as other parts of Hertfordshire and beyond.

If you need to travel to the airport, you can conveniently catch a bus from various points in Hertford. There are other out-of-town bus and coach services that will take you across country.

HEADING ABROAD

When you're travelling overseas, Luton, Stansted and London City airports are all convenient. Or you could opt for the Eurostar terminal at St Pancras International.

BY BIKE

Follow the trails through Panshanger Park or take to the riverside towpaths. You'll find cyclists well catered for in this part of the world.

ON FOOT

From Oakwood you can enjoy a number of walks into town, through the park, along the river or across the fields.





Shared Ownership is designed so that you can buy a new home with a lower deposit and with monthly housing costs that are approximately 20% lower than if you were to buy the same home outright on the open market.

With Shared Ownership, you buy a share in your new home or a resale home usually between 25% and 75% of the full market value of the home. You also pay rent, which is initially capped at a maximum of 2.75%, on the part owned by Network Homes. In addition a service charge is payable per month.

You will need to have savings to cover any deposit required by your

mortgage lender and the costs involved in moving.

When you can afford to, you can take your next steps and increase the share you own; this is known as 'staircasing'. The cost of the additional share that you buy will be based on the current market value of your home.

To buy through shared ownership you will need to do what is known as 'maximise your affordability'. What this means is that you will be required to take out a mortgage for the share that you are purchasing and any deposit you may have. Even if you can afford to buy the minimum share of the property in

cash, you will still be required to take out a mortgage.


Every application needs to be assessed on an individual basis and you will be required to purchase the maximum share you can afford.

STAIRCASING

Following the initial purchase, you have the option of increasing your share when you can afford to do so. This is called 'staircasing' which means you could eventually own all of the property. The benefit is the more you own, the less rent you pay.


