


Truly connected

From your new home it's just a 10-minute walk to Hendon Central tube station, where the Northern line can whisk you into town.

Bus connections can take you to Finchley, Highgate, Golders Green and Wembley with ease.

Just 10 minutes' drive away, the overground train line from Hendon Station can take you to Luton airport directly, or to St Pancras International Station in 16 minutes.

BRENT CROSS

Shopping and eateries are just 15 minutes' walk away. You'll find your favourite home stores, fashion labels and technology outlets under one roof. Cafes and restaurants are there to meet every occasion whether it's a quick pit-stop or a proper meal out.

WEMBLEY BOXPARK

HAMPSTEAD HIGH STREET

Independent butchers and bakers jostle with high street names while the nearby Hampstead Heath is perfect for sprawling away a lazy Sunday.





PRIMROSE HILL

One of the prettiest high streets in London is a half hour train ride away, offering cafes, pubs and restaurants wide a wide range of cuisines.

Close to the iconc Primrose Hill park, 62 acres of parkland offer iconic views of the London skyline as well as access to the Regent's Canal.

BOROUGH MARKET

Further afield, Borough Market is a 45 minute train ride away, a historic food market offering a vast variety of seasonal cuisine and dining opportunities.

Meet up with friends for a night out in the very centre of the capital, while relaxing in the knowledge that home is less than an hour away.

You can explore a healthy lifestyle in the plentiful green spaces in and around Upper & Lower Fosters. With the Welsh Harp Reservoir, Golders Hill Park and Kenwood House all nearby too, you'll never be short of outdoor spaces and activities to enjoy.

It has picnic areas, nesting islands for birds and opportunities to go sailing, paddleboarding and canoeing in the fresh air. 




Less than two miles away there's something for everyone at Golders Hill Park. A beautiful landscaped park, with a children's play area, cafe and even a small zoo, it's bound to be a hit with the family, all year round.

Also within easy reach, is one of London's hidden gems, Kenwood House. At this English Heritage site, not only can you enjoy the stunning interiors and world-class art collection, including paintings by Rembrandt, Turner and Constable; but increase your step-count too as you explore the 112 acres of glorious parkland and idyllic gardens.










Historic Hendon

Your new home is situated in a highly historic location – near Brent Street in Hendon where a small hamlet stood since at least 1613. Weary travellers would stop to use a parish pump while ne'er do wells were locked up in a cage for criminals which is marked with a blue plaque.

An area for industry, several small factories opened here in the 20th century including Tilley Lamps which created 'Aladdin lamps' in the swinging '30s. 18th century houses still stand in some areas while The Pillar boutique hotel was once a rescue home for 'fallen women' and now offers luxury rooms and function suites.

Famous alumni from the area include renowned 16th-century cartographer John Norden, politician Peter Mandelson, author Ruth Prawer Jhabvala and Rabbi Lionel Blue.



Can't afford a full mortgage? Don't have a hefty deposit to buy outright? Why not try buying a share of your home and renting the rest?

Shared Ownership lets you buy between 25% and 75% of the full value. Your deposit is based on the share you buy (not the full value). Each month you'll pay a mortgage on the share you own and pay rent to Sage Homes for the remaining share.

Over time you can buy more shares in your home (called 'staircasing') right up to 100%.

Why Shared Ownership?

Topaz wants to buy her next home and wants a newbuild that costs £300,000. She's found a two year fixed rate mortgage at 5% but wants to look at her options.

Topaz buys a home at full market value (5% deposit and 5% fixed rate mortgage)

Deposit: £15,000

Monthly mortgage payments: £1,685

2 Topaz buys a Shared Ownership home. She mortgages for 25% of the home with a 2.75% fixed rate mortgage, renting the other 75%.)

Deposit: £3,750

Monthly mortgage and rent payments: £937 (£421 mortgage; £516 rent)

Topaz buys a Shared Ownership home, but a higher percentage. She mortgages for 50% of the home at the 2.75% fixed rate, renting the other 50%.

Deposit: £7,500 Monthly mortgage and rent payments: £1,186

Shared ownership could save Topaz nearly £18,000 over two years and will give her a new, energy-efficient home.
