




Knights Quarter

Part of Winchester's charm is that almost everything can be reached in a short and picturesque stroll – it's a compact city that's readily accessible from your base at Knights Quarter. Meet friends for brunch, savour a spot of retail therapy, soak up the sunshine on the cathedral green or indulge in twilight cocktails – it's all within an easy walk.

When it's time to head out of the city you have a choice of excellent road networks and a fast and frequent rail service. Let the train take the strain – it's just over an hour to London Waterloo, and you can be in central Southampton in under 20 minutes, Basingstoke in 15 or Bournemouth in 50.

By car, it's quick to access nearby major routes – you can reach the A34 and M3 J9 within ten minutes, and local road networks offer a gateway to picture–postcard Hampshire; the South Downs National Park and the beaches of the south coast are all within an easy drive.

And if you're taking to the skies, it's a short journey to nearby Bournemouth and Southampton airports, Heathrow is an hour's drive and you can reach Gatwick in 90 minutes.


