Our homes at Auckland Rise and Sylvan Hill are beautifully designed one and two bedroom apartments in a quiet enclave with wonderful views to the south east.

A collection of five new buildings are dotted across the leafy Sylvan Hill community in Upper Norwood, just a short stroll from the shops and cafés of Crystal Palace.

This scheme includes 41 apartments available through shared ownership, perfect for first time buyers and anyone who longs for a green view and a sense of space, with an easy commute into Central London.





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Each new building is of modest proportions, with fewer than 20 or so homes per block, so there's an intimate and friendly feel, and the sloped setting offers great views.

The apartments are generously proportioned, offering open and light-flooded spaces. We've used natural materials such as timber parquet flooring in living areas, and timber accessories in kitchens and bathrooms.
