If you work remotely, but like company, you have the TMRW Coworking Space a 4-minute walk away (not to mention great coffee shops nearby).





There are several great places to meet, eat and drink an easy stroll from Boulevard Point. Just around the corner, you can enjoy a craft ale at the Green Dragon or while away the hours at board-game bar The Ludoquist. You can call in for coffee at Crushed Bean or savour cocktails and pasta at upscale Italian restaurant, Ponte Nuevo.

And, within a 10-minute walk, there are fantastic restaurants from all kinds of gastronomy – from Turkish at Atesh to Sri Lankan at Machan Kitchen and Spanish at Galicia.

And Fairfield Halls is South London's largest arts centre and a major venue for concerts, plays, films and comedy nights.

Other options for entertainment are wide and varied too. Movie lovers can choose from screenings at Vue Cinema or the intimate David Lean Cinema or Croydon Clocktower. For adrenaline junkies there's Escape Room, for families there's Tenpin Bowling and for night owls there are many much-loved bars and clubs in Croydon's centre.

Within a 30-minute drive, there's even more to enjoy – from go-karting at Surbiton Raceway to horseracing at Epsom Downs and thrill seeking at Chessington World of Adventures.

Croydon Clocktower





Centrale & Whitgift is Croydon's flagship shopping centre and is just an 8-minute walk from Boulevard Point. There, you'll find Zara, M&S, Next and more. On the edge of town, a 9-minute drive or 19-minute bus journey away, is the Valley Park Retail Centre, home to Ikea and stores such as Dunelm, Sports Direct, DFS and Boots. And, for serious splurging, you can be at London's Oxford Circus in around 40 minutes.

For everyday essentials, you can walk to Sainsbury's Local in 2 minutes, a large Sainsbury's in 11 minutes and Waitrose in 9 minutes. And you can get to Aldi by bus in 8 minutes.





GREEN AND PLEASANT LAND

Not only are you conveniently close to Croydon's centre at Boulevard Point, you have several open green spaces nearby too. Whether you enjoy running, walking, picnicking, kicking a ball or kicking back with a book, there's a place for you.

The immaculate Queen's Gardens are just a 6-minute walk away. Wandle Park, with its pond, river, playground, skate park and trim trail, is a 10-minute walk. And at Park Hill Park, a 13-minute walk away, you can play tennis and basketball, visit the playground and wander in the historic walled garden. Only slightly further afield, a 10-minute cycle away, is the much larger Lloyd Park.








GLORIOUS HILLS AND SEA AIR



FAST TRAVEL LINKS

Croydon offers everything you need, right on your doorstep. But if you do need to travel, the excellent nearby connections make things really easy.



BY BUS

There are bus stops on the high street just around the corner from Boulevard Point. And Croydon has a good bus network with routes running across and out of town and up into London.

BY CAR

The Enterprise Car Club in Croydon's centre allows hourly and daily self-service hire. Boulevard Point is close to the A232, which takes you east and west to the M25, and Purley Way, which leads north to London and south to Brighton.



BY PLANE

Gatwick Airport:

around 33 minutes by car or 27 minutes public transport.

Heathrow Airport:

around an hour by car or 1.25 hours by public transport.








