Explore the great outdoors close to home. Southwark boasts a wealth of open spaces from majestic parks, woodland, community farms and sports facilities.



3. Elephant Springs



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



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Burgess Park

Burgess Park is one of south London's largest parks showcasing stunning panoramic views of the city skyline.

Burgess Park is a well known and loved Southwark landmark, with 56 hectares stretching from Camberwell and Walworth in the west to Peckham and the Old Kent Road in the east. It is a hub for sports and fitness, featuring cricket and football pitches as well as tennis courts, fishing spots and even a BMX track.





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Stay Connected

With its enviable location within zones 1 and 2, the borough of Southwark is a thriving hub of connectivity with an impressive 6 tube stations (across the Bakerloo, Northern and Jubilee lines), 6 London Overground stations, 620 bus stops and 46 bicycle docking stations throughout the borough enabling efficient and fast links into the City, central London and beyond.

The extensive regeneration of Elephant & Castle has improved connectivity linking Walworth to the rejuvenated pedestrian-friendly town centre. Getting about on two-wheels is actively encouraged with the addition of the north-south Cycle Superhighway on Blackfriars Road which passes through Burgess Park.

Every aspect of the development supports community and connectivity with spacious living areas that are perfect for entertaining friends and shared outside spaces where you can meet your neighbours.



2. Kitchen/dining area



Floor to ceiling windows flood living areas in an abundance of natural light, while private terraces or balconies allow you access to that all important private outside space within the comfort of your own home.



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

On the horizon

The Southwark Living collection will continue to expand its portfolio of exciting developments across the Southwark area, championing new much-needed homes in this dynamic and ever-evolving part of London.

Following the success of New Kent Row, two more developments are due to release, Parkhouse Square and Glengall Rise, both located close to Burgess Park and both offering homes for Open Market Sale and Shared Ownership.



Glengall Rise

Glengall Rise, located to the east of Burgess Park, houses 109 one, two and three bedroom shared ownership apartments and 16 one and two bedroom open market sale apartments. As well as benefitting from proximity to Burgess Park's cycle superhighway connections, green space, and facilities, Glengall Rise provides residents with a private, central outdoor courtyard.

This distinctive, environmentally friendly development retains its original kiln chimney as a key architectural feature, in addition to high ceilings that offer a greater sense of space and enhanced natural ventilation.

The nearest underground tube station is Elephant & Castle.



Parkhouse Square

Parkhouse Square will arrive as part of the greater green evolution of Southwark, offering a highly sustainable lifestyle on the edge of Burgess Park, with 128 one, two and three bedroom homes, 92 of which will be offered under shared ownership. Cycle routes through Burgess Park will connect residents to London's cycle Superhighways, with rooftop amenity spaces providing views over the park.

In addition to the environmental benefits of living adjacent to Burgess Park's green open space and sports amenities, Parkhouse Square offers an endless array of adventures in nearby districts Elephant & Castle, and Peckham. Each neighbourhood offers a unique mixture of social venues, entertainment opportunities and cultural experiences to explore.

The nearest underground tube stations are Kennington and Elephant & Castle, and on the overground Denmark Hill and Peckham Rye.

Home Buying Options

Shared Ownership

Shared Ownership is a Government-backed scheme to help you get on the property ladder with a smaller deposit. You initially purchase between 25%-75% of the home's market value, you then pay subsidised rent on the remainder.

To be considered eligible for the Shared Ownership scheme your yearly income must be below £90,000 within London, or £80,000 outside of London. You cannot buy with Shared Ownership whilst you own another home.

Open Market Sale

If you're not eligible for a Shared Ownership scheme, you can buy with Open Market Sale. Open Market Sale is the traditional way of buying a property. Purchasing the entire property.

Whether you buy it outright or with a mortgage, you become the sole owner of the property (or co-owners if you buy it with someone else).


